



Step: 1


Example A Prepare area to be patched by clean cutting damaged area.

Example B

Use spray cleaner on the surface to be patched. <u>Example C</u>

Clean thoroughly with paper towels/rags to remove all dirt, grease, debris to achieve maximum patch hold.

Example D Allow to dry completely before applying patch .



Step: 2

Example E Cut desired amount of PETACKS patch material to be used.

Example F

Round off corners of PETACKS patch material for maximum hold.



Step: 3

xample G

Peel backing away from the PETACKS patch material and apply it to the fabric evenly by hand as not to allow any air pockets or folds in the material

Example I

Use of a fabric roller or flatten the PETACKS patch material by hand to remove any wrinkles.

(Optional) Gentle Use of a Heat Gun or blow dryer over the PETACKS patch material can aid in increasing bond strength and flattening of material preventing edges from fraying.

Step: 4

Example J & K

For maximum patch efficiency, if possible add a patch to the opposite side of the tarp you previously patched by restarting at Step:1. This will increase the strength of the PETACKS patch material and prevent any future tears

When both PETACKS patch's are complete your tarp is repaired and ready to use immediately.
